NETWORK FOSTERING THE EUROPEAN WORK-BASED
LEARNING SYSTEM FOR VET PROVIDERS



EU Member States have different Vocational Educational and Training (VET) systems; however, they all need to become more relevant to both learners and companies. NEW VET partners strongly share the belief that promoting effective Work Based Learning approaches (i.e. apprenticeships and other forms) can raise the quality of training for young people and increase the VET attractiveness.

GOALS

NEW VET “**Network fostering the European Work-based learning system for VET providers**”, co-funded by the EU Erasmus+ (KA3) programme, wants to foster partnership and cooperation among VET providers to become effective actors in supporting VET reforms at national and European levels. NEW VET will increase the quality of national VET systems by promoting the effective implementation to EU recommendations and tools. The project will also raise the awareness on the Work- Based Learning system to make VET a more popular and attractive choice.



ACTIVITIES

- **Transnational capacity building programme** to create a European community where partners share experiences of well-established models for VET cooperation practices. Capacity building will prepare the groundwork for new cooperation activities to be implemented within the national networks and it will result in possible cross-border partnerships at European level.
- **Empowerment of multilevel cooperation experiences** by developing internationalisation strategies to foster the mobility of leaders, staff and VET learners. This activity will also promote new cooperation experiences with other actors of national and European WBL frameworks.
- **Implementation of joint coaching programmes** by involving pilot groups of teachers, trainers, and/or VET leaders to support their professional development on EU VET tools and policies.
- **Contribution to the European Vocational Skills Week** by organising events and activities at country levels to raise the attractiveness of VET.

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
